

Spring Valley School's Open Campus Policy

Spring Valley School is an open campus. The school and its staff do not undertake any duty to supervise the students. If parents want to restrict their child from leaving campus (if 9 years old and above) or keep their child out of certain parts of the campus (at any age), they must arrange such a restriction directly with their child.

Students with off-campus permission must have a photo I.D. card in their possession and this form signed with permission on file with the Office Corporation. Students are responsible for signing-out when they leave campus, including information of their destination and an approximate time of return. Students must phone the school and speak to a staff member if they will be more than 15 minutes late. Students are responsible for signing-in when they return. These records are kept on file at the school.

The school is not responsible for students while they are off-campus. All students are expected to follow all School Meeting Laws while off-campus.

The School may organize official, school-sponsored field trips, called "School Excursions." Students who join an Excursion must have their parent or guardian sign an additional Field Trip Permission Form. School Excursions are the only off-campus activities supervised by staff and chaperones.

The open campus policy does not change the student's responsibility to attend school.
